



Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association Scholarship Program

The scholarship program is designed to provide families of the Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association Member Agencies an opportunity to be involved in fun, enjoyable, quality programs that they may not be able to afford without assistance. Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association programs are designed to enhance participants' abilities in recreation, leisure and social settings.

To be eligible for a scholarship, the Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association participant and/or family must meet the following requirements:

1. Reduced fees will be limited to three (3) programs per person per brochure season.
2. Reduced fees will only be granted for programs solely sponsored by Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association.
3. Families must reside within the corporate limits of the member agencies. Proof of residency is required. (i.e. -Voter's registration card, current driver's license, monthly bill with address).
4. There will be no full reductions given. More partial assistance will be given so more people may participate. It will be the judgment of Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association to determine final amount of the fee reduction.
5. If applicant is granted, participants must follow current registration guidelines and pay their portion of the program fees upon registration. Payment plans will be arranged to help with the payment of remaining expenses if needed.
6. Applications are reviewed in strict confidence. All applicants will be notified by phone or mail about their status and level of subsidy or if additional information is needed.
7. Being granted Youth Fee Assistance does not guarantee your placement in Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association programs. Every participant will also have to follow our registration guidelines, which are listed in our program guide.
8. Child Care Resource Service helps income-eligible parents who are working and/or going to school pay for their child care. Eligibility is based on the family size and income.
